## **Functions of the Commission**

The People's Constitution Commission Act [Subsection(6(1) (a) (b)] establishes two main duties for the Commission:

- (1) To conduct a comprehensive review of the Belize Constitution; and
- (2) To prepare and submit to the Prime Minister, a final report on its findings.

## Scope of the Commission

The People's Constitution Commission Act also indicates that the Commission must consider the following while performing its duty:

- (1) Create and keep a **record of views** and public opinions and take them into account if these are considered appropriate;
- (2) Adhere to national values & ethos;
- (3) Safeguard and promote: the existence of Belize as a sovereign independent State, the democratic system and the protection of fundamental rights and freedoms; the separation of powers, the national unity, and the secularism of the country.
- (4) At the same time, the Commission must safeguard and promote the

- policies of the State that promote:
- (a) Belizean **territory** and its **sovereignty**; (b) **elimination** of economic and social **privilege** and disparity;
- (c) gender equality; (d) protection of individual's liberties; (e) preservation of cultural values of citizens and indigenous peoples; (f) preservation of property rights; (g) prohibition of exploitation of man by man or by the state; (h) fundamental rights and freedoms, generally; (i) a just system of social security and welfare; (j) the protection of the environment; and (k) international cooperation.

In summary: the Commission cannot amend nor repeal any existing legal framework of the Belize Constitution.

## Time and Money

- The Commission must present its final report within 18 months(May 2024).
- The Auditor General must audit the use of the public money.
- The Members shall be paid such allowances as may be determined by the Minister [Subsection 14(2)].
- The funds of the Commission shall consist of:
  - (i) monies appropriated to the Commission by the National Assembly; and
  - (ii) donations received from any lawful source approved by the Minister [Subsection 19(a)(b)
